Troubleshooting steps for Cellucore cameras

Please read through these steps before performing.

SD CARDS

Verify you have the correct SD:



The Cellucore cameras are especially particular.

Reset camera

Turn off camera pull SD card and batteries wait 30 seconds put back together turn on

Reformat SD card on computer.

We suggest reformatting new ones as well as they can come from the factory with corrupted files on them.

POWER

BATTERIES

Verify you have fresh batteries in the camera. Bushnell suggests lithium batteries.

ANTENNAS

Check your antenna for any damage and remove from camera then when reattaching it please make sure the connection is clean and dry,

SOLAR PANELS: Cellucore 20- solar only

The solar panel will be completely dead when it arrives: Get it charged for use.

- 1. Disconnect the solar panel from camera.
- 2. Set the panel out in sun for 2 days. Reconnect to camera.

SIM CARD RESET

CELLUCORE V20 and A20 models Only

Reset sim card
Similar to the SD card,
Push on panel to unseat it.
Pull the SIM card
use a non-abrasive cloth to wipe down the card.
Blow out the slot, dry canned air best
wait 30 seconds and reseat sim card.



After these steps have been completed it is a good idea to wait about 24 hours.

This gives the camera ample time to connect to the nearest cell servoce tower.

CelluCORE series cameras use available 4G networks – your personal phone may be using 5G, so the signal strength may not be the same
